

As King's classes are listed as part of Dalhousie offerings, King's follows the decisions made by Dalhousie in circumstances of weather-induced closures. As such, if Dalhousie (Halifax Campus) is closed <u>for weather-related reasons</u>, King's will also be closed. Conversely, when Dalhousie is open, King's is open.

Here is where you will find out if Dal/King's is closed:

- 1. on the main page of King's website
- 2. on the radio
- 3. on the main page of the Dalhousie website
- 4. through Dalhousie's Dal Safe app
- 5. through an email to all students
- 6. through an email to faculty and staff from the President's Office
- 7. via King's social media (i.e. Twitter, Facebook)

For immediate notifications, we encourage all students, faculty and staff to download Dalhousie's Dal Safe app which informs the community of all emergency notifications, including storm days. On a **FYP-specific note**, should Dalhousie (Halifax campus) close for only the morning and thus the FYP lecture cancelled, all FYP tutorials that day will also be cancelled. If there is a storm closure on an essay day, essays will be due the morning of the next FYP lecture.
